CAMPUS SAVE ACT

WHAT IS THE CAMPUS **SAVE ACT** ?

The **CAMPUS SAVE ACT** is the Violence Against Women Act's amendments to the **CLERY ACT**.



WHAT DOES THE **CAMPUS SAVE AMENDMENTS** DO FOR STUDENTS?

It expands the scope of the legislation in terms of **REPORTING**, **RESPONSE**, and **PREVENTION EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS** around domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, and stalking.

SURVIVOR'S RIGHTS

INSTITUTION'S POLICY MUST INCLUDE:



SURVIVORS' option to, or not to, **NOTIFY AND SEEK ASSISTANCE** from law enforcement and campus authorities.



SURVIVORS' rights and institutional responsibilities regarding **JUDICIAL NO-CONTACT**, **RESTRAINING**, and **PROTECTIVE ORDERS**.



A standard of **EVIDENCE**.



WRITTEN NOTIFICATION OF ACCESS TO ON AND OFF CAMPUS ACCOMODATIONS related to academic, living, transportation, and working situation even if survivors do not report.

INSTITUTION'S POLICY MUST INCLUDE:

Protect a **SURVIVORS' CONFIDENTIALITY**.



Provide written notification of a **SURVIVORS' RIGHTS** and **OPTIONS**.



Provide a clear **DESCRIPTION** of the **DISCIPLINARY** process and all possible sanctions.



Offer the accuser and the accused the right to have an **ADVISOR** of choice present at any meeting or disciplinary proceeding.



Implement annual **TRAINING** for officials conducting disciplinary proceedings.
