

## **Bilingual Therapist-Traditional/Outpatient**

### Description:

- Must be fluent in English and Spanish
- Strong clinical and communication skills
- Able to collaborate effectively and professionally with all community partners, children, caregivers, supervisor and co-workers
- Strong computer skills, Microsoft Outlook, Excel, Word and web-based Electronic Health Record
- Well organized, detail oriented and skilled with time/task management, able to adapt to frequent changes
- Ability to provide field based work
