

HUB-Clinical Supervisor -Youth Placement Stabilization Teams

JOB DESCRIPTION:

- Ensure that Clinicians are providing Intensive Care Coordination Services and In-Home Based Services (ICC/IHBS) which may include brief psychotherapeutic interventions and that Case Managers are providing Therapeutic Behavioral Services (TBS), linkage, and rehabilitation groups. Provide therapists and case managers with clinical supervision and are on-call 24/7 (on rotation) for after-hours crisis rotation staff.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Ability to work collaboratively with members of inter-disciplinary teams; and ability to provide ongoing clinical consultation to DCFS and DMH;
- Develop relationships and ongoing communication with DCFS workers and other staff.
- Hire, supervise and evaluate assigned clinicians and case managers;
- Assignment of cases;
- Experience in community-based work to include home visits, individual and group therapy and Therapeutic Behavioral Services (TBS);
- Knowledge of county/public agencies, including Emergency Psychiatric Services;
- Ability to provide oversight of clinical services, ensure that the needs of clients are met and services meet contract requirements;
- Conduct psychological testing as needed;
- Respond to crisis and provide problem resolution;
- Is available (on rotation) for crisis support to clients 24/7
- Responsible for regular scheduled weekly individual supervision, clinical department meetings and Child and Family Team Meetings (CFTs);
- Maintain all appropriate records including program productivity, clinical notes and other records as required.

OTHER FUNCTIONS:

- Follow agency policies and procedures;
- Maintain scheduling/coverage of “on call” schedules;
- Participate in VIP in-service training programs; and
- Perform other duties as assigned.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS:

- Licensed Ph.D/Psy.D degree and two (2) years documented supervisor experience in a mental health setting;
- LPS designated or willing to be trained;
- Spanish speaking a plus;
- Self-starter, independent supervisor with the ability to adapt to change in a fast working environment;
- Good written and verbal communication skills.
